DIRECTIONS

Travelling to Burnley General and the Royal Blackburn Hospital

Both hospitals are well served by public transport services. Note that there is a free of charge shuttle bus between the two hospitals. Allow 30 minutes for this journey. If you are travelling by car please park on a 'visitors' pay and display car park. Further information and a timetable for the shuttle bus are available on our website www.elht.nhs.uk.

Burnley General Hospital

On foot – follow the signs for the Urgent Care Centre and continue past this with the entrance on your right. Continue past the McKenzie Medical Centre Library and you will find the Training and Development Centre on your left. Enter through the main door and ask at reception to be directed to the correct training room.

Royal Blackburn Hospital

On foot – You will arrive at the main entrance to the hospital. Walk towards the doors and rather than entering turn right and walk up a slight incline. Cross the road diagonally and go down the steps into the car park. Walk down the slope of the car park and turn right onto the road, heading towards the barriers at the entrance to this part of the hospital. Just before you reach the barriers turn left and then walk straight ahead to the entrance to the Learning and Development Centre. Ask at reception for directions to the required seminar room.
