

Concession parking arrangements at the Royal Blackburn Teaching Hospital for visitors to patient's whose stay is greater than one week, and are visiting on a daily basis.

For the duration of the time a patient is in hospital, every 3 consecutive days paid for, a pass will be issued that will cover the next 4 visits.

To qualify for this concession parking please complete the box below. Ask one of the ward staff to sign it and bring it along with 3 consecutive days receipts with a minimum value of £10.50 (i.e.3 receipts for £3.50 or if you make two visits per day 6 x £1.90 receipts over 3 days) to the car parking service desk situated in the main entrance. You will then be issued a car parking ticket that will allow access to the car park on four separate occasions. **THE TICKET WILL BE VALID FOR 7 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF ISSUE.**

DO NOT PRESS THE BUTTON FOR A TICKET, PLEASE USE THE TICKET THAT HAS BEEN ISSUED AT THE CAR PARKING SERVICE DESK.

When this ticket has expired you must then obtain receipts as above to qualify again for this concession. You do not need another signed letter just write your postcode, patients name and ward number, on the back of the receipts.
