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The Trust currently has 2 staff members who have completed a 5 day human factors train the trainers course and are now delivering on a monthly basis a one day in house Introduction to Human Factors training since Feb 2019. The trust is in the process of training another 7 staff to become trainers to allow an increase in the number of sessions available for any staff member to book and attend. The Trust also runs a number of simulation training sessions which includes Human Factors discussions around how to improve safety.
